Rules

For this Event, the following Rules and Procedures will apply:

- ✚ An Official must be in attendance for Arena Familiarisation to commence.
- ✚ Arena Familiarisation is to be conducted around the outside of the white surrounds of the Arena only (not in the actual competition arena).
- ✚ Mounted only.
- ✚ Led horses, and/or any accompanying grooms/agents on foot, will not be permitted to participate in Arena Familiarisation.
- ✚ Identification numbers (at least one number) must be worn on the bridle or saddle blanket. The only exception is for any unregistered pony or horse that is competing as a "Participant".
- ✚ Stallions must wear green stallion discs.
- ✚ The pace, and rein, will be at the direction of the Official.
- ✚ At the direction of the Official, any unruly pony or horse will be removed if it is considered to be too dangerous to participate in Arena Familiarisation.
- ✚ Any person not following the directions of the Official; or not adhering to any of the eight "EA Codes of Conduct"; or Conditions of Entry of this Event; or current EA Rules and Guidelines, are to be directed to the Event Steward or a Member of the Organising Committee.
- ✚ EA Dressage Rule 1.5.1 – A Yellow Warning Card may be imposed for:
 - Abuse of Horse;
 - Abuse of Official;
 - Failure to follow a direction of an Official.
